On March 6, 1992, we met with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by denying the grievant the right to attend the Step 2 meeting with the union representative.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that this case will be settled in accordance with the Step 4 settlement in case H4N-1E-C 28034, which states: "The necessity of the presence of a grievant at a Step 2 meeting is determined by the union."


Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.
