Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Maximization/Full-time Flexible-NALC requires that the six month period be consecutive.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. The six month measuring period in the MOU means six consecutive months.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case to the parties at the Regional level for appropriate disposition.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
