The issue in this grievance is whether the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Maximization/Full-time Flexible-NALC requires that the six month period be consecutive.


After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. The six month measuring period in the MOU means six consecutive months.
