Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

On March 6, 1992, we met with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by denying the grievant access to a supervisor's records concerning him.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. This grievance should be decided in accordance with the provisions of ELM 313 and 314, based on the particular fact circumstances involved.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary, in accordance with the above understanding.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
