Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. In the Segmentation Settlement Agreement, of March 9, 1987, the following was agreed to:

A manual tertiary or delivery operation will be done by city delivery letter carriers provided the mail is for city delivery routes or post office box section served by these routes and provided there is space available at the delivery unit," (emphasis added).

Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at the Regional Level for further processing of the above.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
