Dear Mr. Hutchins:

On February 19, 1992, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance currently pending national level arbitration.

The issue in this grievance is whether part-time flexible employees required to work on a holiday will be included on the holiday schedule posted no later than Tuesday preceding the service week in which the holiday falls.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that the posting of a holiday schedule on the Tuesday preceding the service week in which the holiday falls will include part-time flexible employees who at that point in time are scheduled to work on the holiday in question.

When additional part-time employees are scheduled subsequent to the Tuesday posting, there is no entitlement to additional compensation for those part-time flexibles employees who are subsequently scheduled.

Finally, nothing in this settlement is intended to provide any additional premium, compensation or remedy not already specifically provided for by the National Agreement or applicable postal regulation.



Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this letter as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case, withdrawing H7N-2L-C 37383 from the pending national arbitration listing.
