Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director of City Delivery, Brian Farris, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether the National Agreement requires management to provide the union with copies of information relevant to the filing of a grievance.

During our discussion, we agreed that upon the request of the union, the Employer will furnish information necessary to determine whether to file or to continue the processing of a grievance, provided that the Employer may require the Union to reimburse the USPS for any costs reasonably incurred in obtaining the information. If obtaining such information includes providing copies, those copies will be provided.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
