On June 3, 1992, I met with your representative to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement in the manner in which it responded to the National Union's request for comparative workhour reports.


During our discussion, we mutually agreed that such requests will not be unreasonably delayed. Normally, such requests shall be responded to within sixty (60) days. On those occasions when requests cannot be responded to within the sixty (60) days, the union will be so advised.
