
Dear Mr. Hutchins:


In a prearbitration settlement of the above referenced case, dated December 9, 1991, it was agreed to develop a joint committee to review the presence of a removable passenger jump seat in a Long Life Vehicle (LLV) from the perspectives of safety and performance.

After further joint discussions by our representatives, we have mutually agreed that the presence of a removable passenger jump seat does not constitute a safety hazard. However, the seat will be removed from the vehicle after use if it is not going to be used again in the immediate future.
