The representatives of the parties recently met to discuss the above-captioned grievance, currently pending national level arbitration.

This grievance concerns the scheduling of an appointment for prescribed medical treatment as a result of a job-related injury.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. After a full review of this matter, it is agreed that an employee cannot be required or compelled by the Postal Service to undergo a scheduled medical examination and/or treatment during nonwork hours.
