Dear Mr. Burrus:

On June 9, 1993, we met to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this grievance is whether management violated the National Agreement by providing the union with a revised list of 100+ man year offices.

During our discussion, we mutually agreed that management will continue to use the list provided to the union at the beginning of the contract period.

We further agreed that a listing of offices will be provided to the union, upon request, at the beginning of each contract period, which will be used for administering the following articles of the National Agreement:

Article 1, Section 6 (100 or more bargaining unit employees)
Article 7, Section 3 (200 or more man years)
Article 8, Section 1 (more than 100 full-time employees)
Article 14, Section 4 (50 or more employees)
Article 14, Section 8A and Transfer MOU (100 or more man years)
Full-Time Flexible MOU (125 or more man years)

Each party has a 30-day period of time to verify the initial listing and make any needed corrections. Once a final list has been developed, it will remain in effect for the term of each National Agreement.


