Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

Recently, a meeting was held with NALC Vice President Lawrence G. Hutchins to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of the contractual grievance procedure.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.

It was agreed that 1) administrative action by the Postal Service does not, in and of itself, affect the official status of an NALC branch organization, and 2) a single Postal installation will be subject to only one NALC LMOU, and the Union representative who signs the LMOU will be the recognized Union Official for the facility.

With these understandings, we agreed to remand this case to the local parties to afford another opportunity to address any unresolved issues.


The decision to remand this issue is made without precedent or prejudice to the position of either party, and is non-citable in any other case or dispute of the same or similar circumstances.
