Recently, a meeting was held with the NALC Director City Delivery, William Young, to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.


After reviewing this matter, we mutually agree that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. When conducting a one-day mail count, the appropriate form to record the carrier's performance is on PS Form 1838-C. The PS Form 1838-C does not specifically measure the carrier's performance by pieces per minute.


Consistent with the above understanding, the parties mutually agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing including arbitration if necessary.
