After reviewing this matter, it is mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case. DPS Implementation: A Training Guide for Delivery Management in Part 4.6 contains specific information concerning what to do if quality deteriorates after attaining the quality threshold. Accordingly, we agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing consistent with the above understanding.
