On July 9, 1982, we met with you to discuss the above-captioned grievance at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The matters presented by you as well as the applicable contractual provisions have been reviewed and given careful consideration.

The issue in the instant grievance involves management's denial of a steward's request to leave the work area to interview a witness.

As final settlement in all matters relating to this dispute, the parties at the National level agree that a steward's request to leave his work area to investigate a grievance shall not be unreasonably denied in accordance with Article XVII, Section 3 of the National Agreement.
