Recently, I met with your representative to discuss the above-mentioned grievance currently at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.

We further agreed that the AMS function is a managerial function which may be delegated, and regardless of the methodology employed to change the information contained on Form 313, the actual work associated with making such changes on Form 313 is letter carrier work.

Accordingly, we mutually agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for further processing, including arbitration if necessary.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to remand this case.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
