Dear Mr. Sombrotto:

On September 20, 1999, I met with your representative to discuss the abovereferenced grievances at the fourth step of our contractual grievance procedure.

The issue in this case is whether or not management violated the National Agreement, specifically ELM 432.32, when it worked a PTF over 12 hours in a day.

The parties mutually agreed that no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in this case.

Whether or not a remedy is due in such circumstances is not an interpretive issue. As such, the parties agreed to remand this case to the parties at Step 3 for application of ELM 432.32 and the Joint Contract Administration Manual (JCAM) pages 8-14 and 8-15.

Accordingly, we agreed to remand these cases to the parties at Step 3 for further processing and application of the above, including arbitration, if appropriate.

Time limits were extended by mutual consent.
