Recently, our representatives met in prearbitration discussions on the above-referenced cases.

The issue in these cases is whether an employee's Form 50 may reflect more than one duty station.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that while no national interpretive issue is fairly presented in these cases, we would resolve them as follows:

An employee's official Form 50 may reflect only one duty station. A Form 50 which lists more than one duty station will be amended to reflect one duty station.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of agreement to settle these cases, removing them from the national arbitration listing.
