- The electronic information for Delivery Confirmation service items will continue to be handled in accordance with the applicable section(s) of the Privacy Act.
- Carriers will not be held liable for loss or theft of signature waiver items for which they have signed as acknowledgement of delivery in accordance with the mailer's or addressee's instructions and postal regulations.
- Time credit will continue to be given during a route count and inspection for the Enhanced Signature Capture activity, as it has been, and will continue to be credited in total street time.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as your acknowledgment of your agreement to settle this grievance, removing it from the national arbitration listing.
