Recently, our representatives met in prearbitration discussion of the above-referenced grievance which resulted in the following agreement:

- Postal Operations Manual (POM) Section 644 through 644.2.c is deleted.
- The parties will meet for the purpose of identifying and resolving any disputes remaining over the changes made with the publication of POM Issue 7.
- Any unresolved dispute from this process on October 6, 2003 will be scheduled, on a priority basis, before National Arbitrator Das.
- This settlement is made without prejudice to the Postal Service's ability to make subsequent changes to the POM pursuant to Article 19 of the National Agreement.
