Dear Mr. Young:

Recently our representatives met in prearbitration discussion of the above-referenced grievance.

The issue in this case is whether the use of the locally developed electronic form at issue violates the National Agreement.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agree that no national interpretive issue is presented in this case. We agree to remand this case to Step B through the National Business Agent with the following understanding:

The parties agree that the locally developed form at issue may not be used in lieu of PS Form 3883, or its electronic equivalent PS Form 3883-A. Use of either PS Form 3883 or 3883-A requires the customer's signature on PS Form 3849 in accordance with current handbooks and manuals.

Please sign and return the enclosed copy of this decision as acknowledgment of your agreement to remand this grievance and remove it from the national arbitration docket.
