Dear Bill:

This is in further reference to my April 17 correspondence regarding the second phase of *PostalPEOPLE* implementation. In this phase, employees in the Capital Metro, Eastern, New York Metro, Northeast, and Southeast Areas will be migrated into the Human Capital Enterprise System (HCES).

The National Association of Letter Carriers National Agreement's requirement to post vacant or newly established duty assignments within five days falls outside of the functionality of HCES. Also, some installations have Local Memorandum of Understanding provisions on posting and bidding that do not match other time periods and requirements of the National Agreement.

To accommodate these requirements, it may be necessary to use manual bid cards following the HCES migration. In the future, we will revisit the system requirements that may make manual bidding a necessity.
