Recently our representatives met at the Interpretive Step to discuss the above referenced case. Time limits were extended by mutual consent.

The issue in this case is whether electronic PS Form 1769/301 required supervisors to obtain from employees potentially sensitive medical information not previously required by the paper version of PS Form 1769.

After reviewing this matter, we mutually agreed that the issue has been resolved. The union's concerns over potentially sensitive medical information were addressed by a USPS Service Change Request. A copy of the change request was provided to the union.
