The issue in this case concerns the impact the mandatory use of bicycle helmets has on the ability of city letter carriers to employ uniform items to protect exposed skin from the sun.

The National Joint Labor-Management Safety Committee, established under Article 14, Section 3.A of the National Agreement, has been meeting on the subject issue in an attempt to resolve this matter. The parties agree to extend the terms of the June 11, 2013 pre-arbitration agreement until February 28, 2014.
