Dear Mr. Rolando:

On several occasions our representatives met at the Interpretive Step of the grievance-arbitration procedure on the above referenced case. Interpretive Step time limits were extended by mutual consent.

This case concerns the assignment of inter-station runs in Reno, Nevada to Highway Contract Route service prior to the effective date of the 2006 collective bargaining agreement.

After reviewing this matter, the parties agree that no national interpretive issue is presented in this case. Accordingly, national case Q01N-4Q-C 07136663 is closed without prejudice to the position of either party.

Local grievance number 709MO 63-07 (Reno, Nevada), which was held by mutual agreement, will be discussed by the local parties for possible resolution within thirty days of this agreement, unless the local parties agree to extend the subject time limit. If no resolution is reached, this grievance will be processed in accordance with Article 15 of the National Agreement.

Any other grievance held pending the outcome of case Q01N-4Q-C 07136663 should be processed in accordance with Article 15 of the National Agreement.
